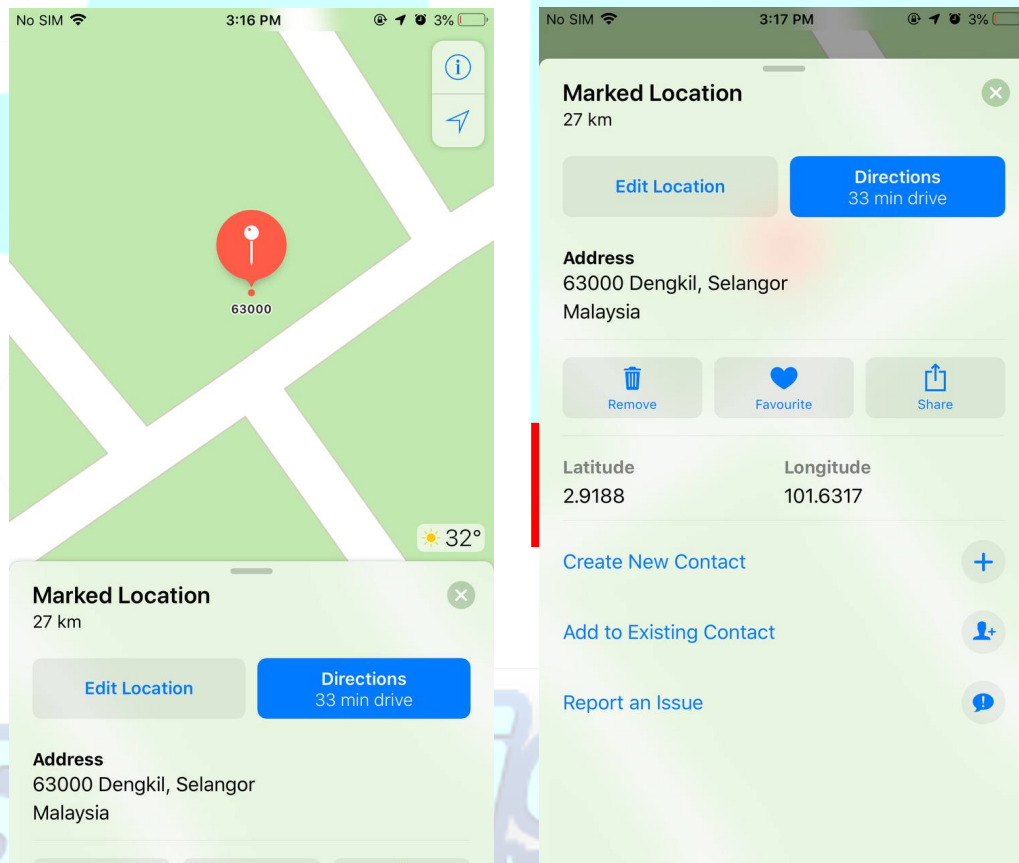


Get Latitude and Longitude from Apple Maps

Open [Maps on your iPhone or iPad](#) and then follow these steps to get your location's coordinates.

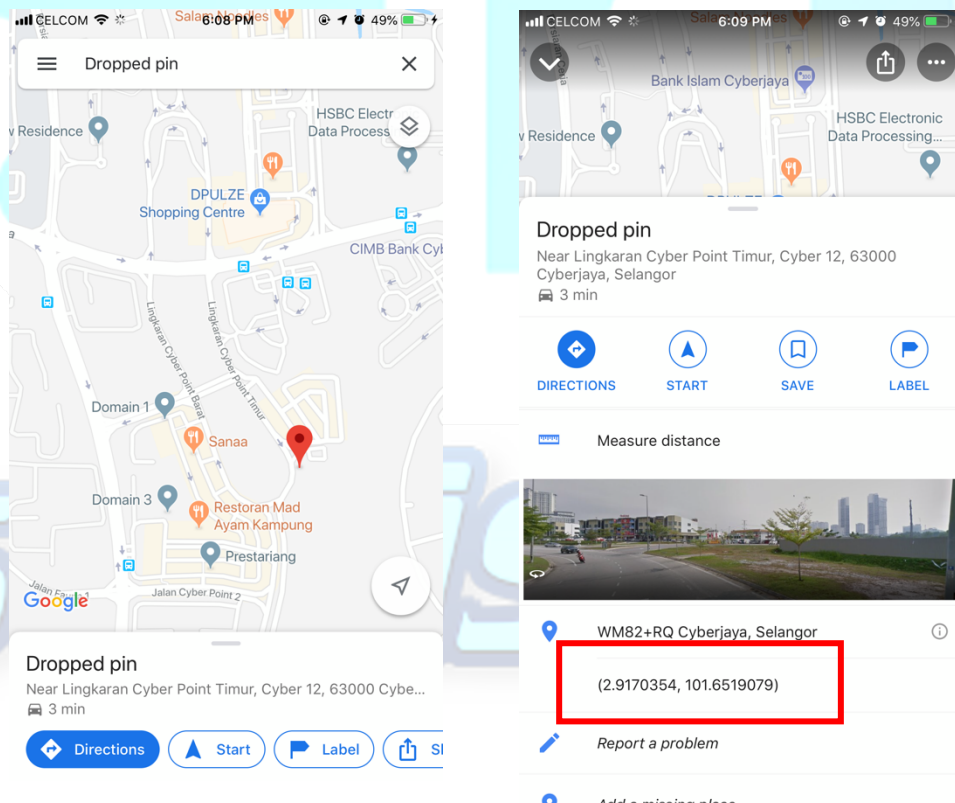
1. Navigate the map's interface and find your desired location.
2. When the location you want appears, **tap and hold it** on the map to add a marker. This will appear as a red pin and show as a "Marked Location".
3. **Swipe up** from the bottom to view full details for the spot including the Latitude and Longitude.



Get Latitude and Longitude from Google Maps

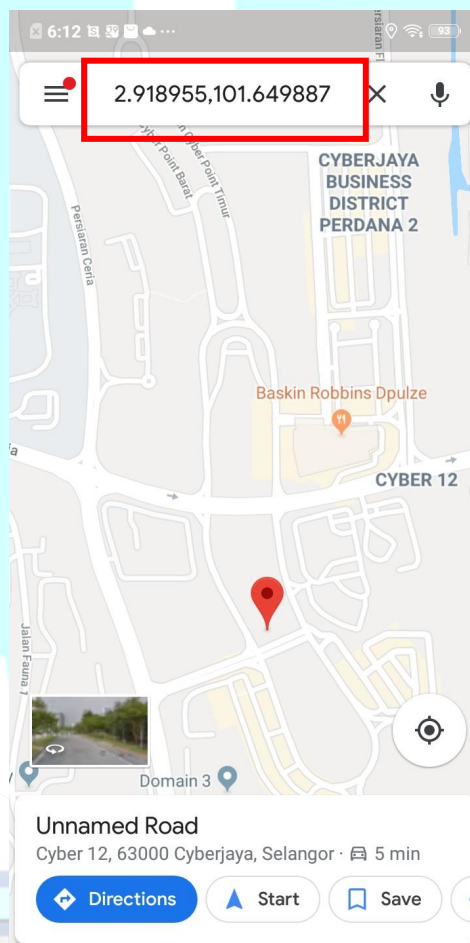
For iPhone

1. Download and open [Google Maps](#) on the App Store.
2. Once you have downloaded the app, tap on it from your phone's home screen to open it.
3. **Drop a pin at the desired location on the map.**
Use your fingers to navigate the map's interface and find your desired location. Tap and hold on the map and hold in order to drop a pin.
4. **Find the latitude and longitude.** The link will launch Google Maps and the location's latitude and longitude will appear at the bottom of the screen
5. Copy the location's latitude and longitude inside the red line box.



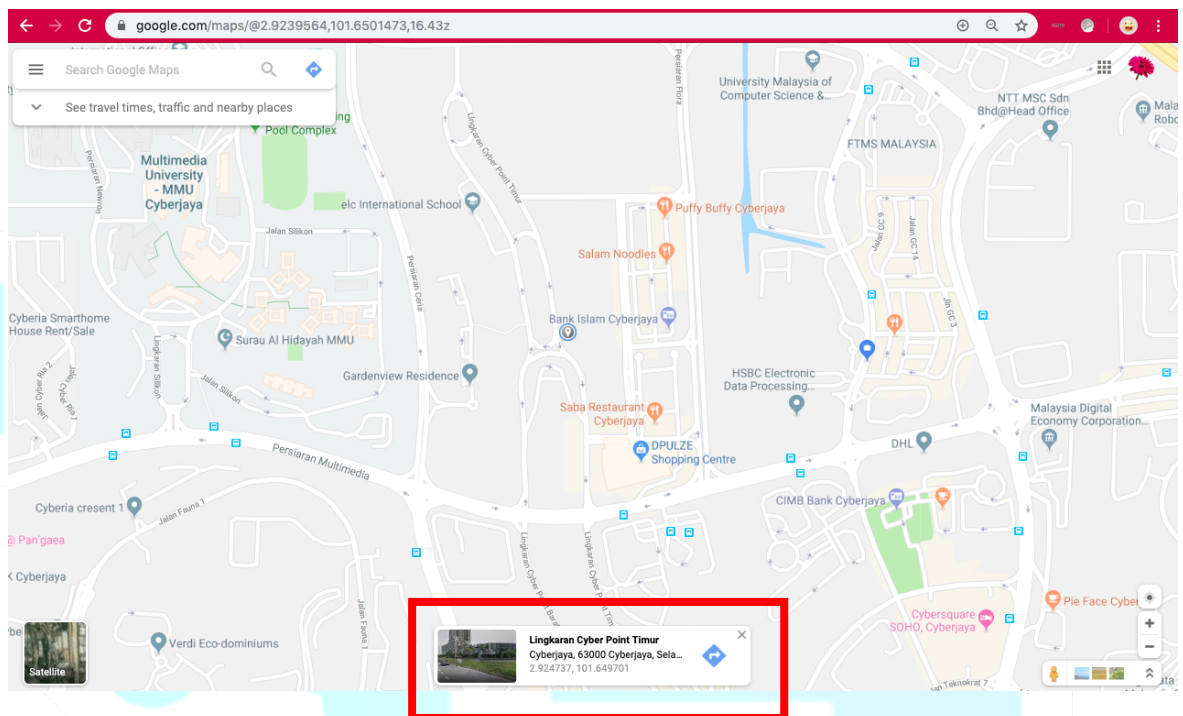
For Android

1. Download and open [Google Maps](#) on Play Store.
2. **Drop a pin where you want to get the latitude and longitude.** Find the location on the map. Tap and hold down on the screen until a red pin appears at the location.
3. **View the location's coordinates.** After you have dropped a pin, look at the search bar at the top of the screen. The location's latitude and longitude will appear in the search bar.



For Desktop Browser

1. Go [google.com/maps](https://www.google.com/maps) . This will open a Google map.
2. **Drop a pin.** Click on the exact location you'd like coordinates for.
3. Once a pin is dropped, the latitude and longitude will be a part of the URL in your address bar, but there's an even simpler way to get the information.
4. **Get your location's latitude and longitude.** The coordinates will be located in a rectangular box that appears on the bottom of your computer screen.



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
